

Call for Breakout Session Proposals

The **2025 Rural Philanthropy Summit: Stronger Together** will be held on **Thursday, April 10, and Friday, April 11, 2025**, at The Lodge of Four Seasons in Lake Ozark, MO.

This year we are introducing *participant-designed/led* breakout sessions. Breakout sessions will be 60 minutes in length and will be presented once on Friday, April 11, either 10:00 – 11:00am or 11:15am – 12:15pm.

Breakout sessions should:

- 1) Present an issue facing rural communities in Missouri
- 2) Include examples of effective, innovative, and/or promising strategies to address this issue
- 3) Specify steps rural funders/rural partners can take to meaningfully address this issue in the communities they serve

We invite you to submit a breakout session proposal for consideration by sending the following information to awingo@cfozarks.org by **Friday, December 6**:

- 1) Title of breakout session
- 2) Names/titles/organizations of all presenters
- 3) Session format (lecture, panel discussion, small group discussion, interactive, etc.)
- 4) Session objectives
- 5) Session description (3-5 sentences)

Sessions where one or more presenters are in-person will be prioritized. Collaboration between funders is encouraged – and you are warmly encouraged to design something *you* would find timely, engaging, and meaningful.
